

## **BYLAW 21385**

### **To amend Revised Bylaw 19979, City of Edmonton Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, Ambleside Integrated Site - Phase I, Amendment #1**

#### **Recommendation**

That Bylaw 21385 be given the appropriate readings.

#### **Purpose**

To amend Revised Bylaw 19979, to increase the borrowing authority by \$2.00 million from \$80.29 million to \$82.29 million.

#### **Readings**

Bylaw 21385 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 21385 be considered for third reading.”

#### **Advertising and Signing**

This Bylaw does not require advertising and the Bylaw can be signed and thereby passed following third reading.

Under section 258(5) of the *Municipal Government Act*, a borrowing bylaw does not need to be advertised unless the increased cost of the project is more than 15 per cent of the original cost of the capital property.

## **REPORT**

The history of the borrowing bylaw is as follows:

- At the March 14, 2022, City Council meeting, Revised Bylaw 19979 was passed; and
- At the May 24, 2022, City Council meeting, Bylaw 20107, Revision of Revised Bylaw 19979, was passed.

## **BYLAW 21385 - To amend Revised Bylaw 19979, City of Edmonton Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, Ambleside Integrated Site - Phase I, Amendment #1**

During the 2025 Spring Supplemental Capital Budget Adjustment deliberation on June 10, 2025, City Council approved a \$2.00 million funding transfer from profile CM-10-0001 Climate Resilient City Facility Upgrades to profile 19-10-1013 Ambleside Integrated Site – Phase I.

As a result, the total cost of profile 19-10-1013 Ambleside Integrated Site – Phase I has increased by \$2.00 million from \$81.79 million to \$83.79 million. Accordingly, the borrowing authority will be increased by \$2.00 million from \$80.29 million to \$82.29 million.

A corresponding amendment under Bylaw 21384 to amend Bylaw 20392, City of Edmonton Integrated Infrastructure Services Project, Climate Resilient City Facility Upgrades, Amendment #4, to decrease the borrowing authority through Financial and Corporate Services report FCS03288rev, is also presented to City Council for second and third readings on March 17, 2026.

Bylaw 21385 is being submitted for three readings with Bylaw 21384.

### **Community Insight**

Borrowing bylaws reflect a legislative requirement of the borrowing process. As a result, no community insight is undertaken with respect to the borrowing bylaw process. Where required by the *Municipal Government Act*, borrowing bylaws are advertised.
