| C623B Edmonton Economic Recovery Grant Approved: June 8, 2020 Last amended: May 4, 2021 | <p>The Edmonton Economic Recovery Grant Policy (C623B) was initially approved in response to the economic hardships created by the COVID-19 pandemic. The grant program created two streams of grants under the Edmonton Economic Recovery Grant: the City Stream for individual businesses (micro grants), and the Business Association Stream. These programs were superseded by the Economic Action Plan Grant.</p> <p>The policy is being recommended for rescinding as the program budget has been exhausted, the pandemic is over, and the economic situation has stabilized. Businesses can continue to seek financial support from other orders of government and process support offered by the Business Friendly Edmonton team and other municipal services.</p> |
| C616 Corner Store Program Policy Approved: June 4, 2019 | The current policy has become outdated and fails to incorporate essential streetscape elements of the program. Converting this to an administrative standard, which is already developed, allows Administration to make more responsive updates while maintaining a sufficient level of oversight and control. |
