

BYLAW 21511 - To repeal the Anti-Racism Advisory Committee Bylaw

Recommendation

That Bylaw 21511 be given the appropriate readings.

Purpose

To repeal the Anti-Racism Advisory Committee Bylaw, Bylaw 18970.

Readings

Bylaw 21511 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving to third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 21511 be considered for third reading.”

REPORT

On March 25, 2026, City Council approved the Governance Framework for Council Committees, which provides a framework for aligning the mandate and lifecycle of Council Committees with approved Council Priorities. Council also provided direction to conclude seven of the 12 Council Committees, including the Anti-Racism Advisory Committee.

As the Anti-Racism Advisory Committee was paused in 2023, if this bylaw is passed the Committee will conclude immediately. There are no active appointments by Council.

Community Insight

This bylaw represents the formal governance mechanism necessary to carry out Council’s decision on March 25, 2026. As a result, no additional community insight was undertaken.
