

## **BYLAW 21512 - To repeal the City of Edmonton Youth Council Bylaw**

### **Recommendation**

That Bylaw 21512 be given the appropriate readings.

### **Purpose**

To repeal the City of Edmonton Youth Council Bylaw, Bylaw 20676.

### **Readings**

Bylaw 21512 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving to third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 21512 be considered for third reading.”

### **REPORT**

On March 25, 2026, City Council approved the Governance Framework for Council Committees, which provides a framework for aligning the mandate and life cycle of Council Committees with approved Council Priorities. As part of that discussion, Council also provided direction to conclude seven of the 12 Council Committees, including City of Edmonton Youth Council. This direction was initially provided in private to allow time for Administration to communicate with the Co-Chairs and members of the Committee in advance of these reports being presented to City Council. These discussions have taken place, and passage of the bylaw to formally conclude the Committee is the final step in the governance process to give effect to the March 25, 2026, City Council decision.

As the terms for members of City of Edmonton Youth Council expire on August 31, 2026, the Committee will conclude on that date. Recruitment for City of Edmonton Youth Council was not included in the most recent civic agencies recruitment campaign as recruitment for this Committee was scheduled for summer in advance of the August 31 term expiries. Applications were accepted for members of Youth at Large, and all applicants have been advised of the decision to conclude City of Edmonton Youth Council.
