## Community Investment Hosting Grant Recommendations

### Recommendation:

That Community Services Committee recommend to City Council:

That the Community Investment Hosting Grant Awards totalling \$52,627.50, as outlined in Attachment 1 of the July 7, 2014, Community Services Advisory Board report CR\_1430, be approved.

### Report Summary

The recommendations in the report provide for the awarding of Hosting Grants to organizations who applied for the March 7, 2014, grant deadline.

### Report

- At the May 27, 2014, Community Services Advisory Board meeting, the board approved the March 7, 2014, Community Investment Hosting Grant Award recommendations, as outlined in Attachment 1, of the July 7, 2014, Community Services Advisory Board report CR\_1430.
- The formula used to generate the grant recommendations was approved at the February 27, 2007, Community Services Advisory Board meeting. This formula is outlined in Attachment 2.
- Twenty-one Community Investment Grant - Hosting Grant applications were received for the March 7, 2014, deadline.
- Of the 21 applications, 18 events were eligible and three were not.
- An overview of the applicants and their requests, event eligibility and award recommendations are outlined in Attachment 3.
- The recommendation is to fund 18 events for a total of \$52,627.50. The Hosting Grant program has two deadlines in 2014: March 7, 2014, and August 29, 2014.

### Policy

- Community Investment Grant Bylaw 14157 delegates the Community Services Advisory Board the authority to review applications from applicants hosting Recreation/Amateur Sport and Multicultural events and made recommendations for grant awards to the Community Services Committee and City Council.
- Policy C211G - Community Investment Grants to Organizations and Individuals and the Community Investment Grants Terms of Reference provide the Community Services Advisory Board the basis to review the applications, set budget amounts and form grant award recommendations.

**Corporate Outcomes**

- Edmontonians are connected to the city in which they live, work and play.

**Justification of Recommendation:**

The Community Investment Hosting Grant Award recommendations are in accordance with the Community Investment Grant Bylaw 14157 and Community Investment Grants to Organizations and Individuals Policy C211G.
