

Community Arts project grant program Program Summary

Purpose

The Community Arts grant program invests in the quality of life in our city by providing funding for projects that are collaborations between professional artists and a distinct community. (A community may be defined by a multitude of factors, including but not limited to, ethnicity, living conditions, geographic location, age, beliefs and traditions, social or economic strata).

Eligibility

Applicants can be individuals or organizations. Individuals must be: an adult, a resident of the greater Edmonton region for at least one year prior to the application deadline, and a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.

Level of support

Projects may be supported to a normal maximum of \$15,000 and normally in support of up to 50% of the expenses of the project.
