

# Bylaw 16858

## Motorcycle Noise

---

### Purpose

To amend the Community Standards Bylaw, Bylaw 14600, to provide greater clarity regarding the definition of sound level meter.

### Readings

Bylaw 16858 is ready for three readings. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 16858 be considered for third reading."

### Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

### Report Summary

**This is a Bylaw to amend the Community Standards Bylaw 14600 regarding motorcycle noise.**

### Previous Council/Committee Action

At the June 16, 2014, Community Services meeting, the following motion was passed:

That Administration prepare amendments to the Community Standards Bylaw, Bylaw 14600, as outlined in Attachment 1 of the June 16, 2014, Community Services report CR\_1174, for consideration by Council.

### Report

The amendments proposed in Bylaw 16858 align exactly with the content of Attachment 1 of the June 16, 2014, Community Services report CR\_1174. As described in CR\_1174, the purpose of these amendments is to provide greater clarity regarding the definition of sound level meters, which are used by Edmonton Police Service to enforce motorcycle noise violations.

### Corporate Outcomes

This Bylaw supports the goal to Improve Edmonton's Livability as described in *The Way We Live*, through the effective enforcement of municipal bylaws.
