


POWER POLES







- Concept 1
 - Remove 1 southbound lane (124 Ave to south of 118 Ave)
 - Construct full boulevard west sidewalk
 - Shared-use path (SUP) on east side
 - 118 Avenue intersection modifications for SUP
- Concept 2
 - 2 southbound lanes
 - West side transit connections only
 - Shared-use path (SUP) on east side
 - 118 Avenue intersection modifications for SUP





Lane Reductions

The traffic volumes along 142 Street are:

•12,000 vpd* (existing) 14,000 vpd (future)

Compared to other 4-lane roads within the City, the volumes are low:


- •30,000 to 40,000 vpd St. Albert Tr
- •22,000 to 26,000 vpd 149 St
- •21,000 to 28,000 vpd 107 Ave



*vpd = vehicles per day



Option Comparison






How We Choose a Concept
