Purpose

Rezoning from (IM) Medium Industrial Zone to (IB) Industrial Business Zone; located at 11507 - 120 Street NW.

Readings

Charter Bylaw 19321 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree "That Charter Bylaw 19321 be considered for third reading."

Advertising and Signing

This Charter Bylaw has been advertised in the Edmonton Journal on June 5, 2020, June 13, 2020, and June 16, 2020. The Charter Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

Position of Administration

Administration supports this proposed Charter Bylaw.

Report

The proposed rezoning will allow for the opportunity for industrial businesses and limited, compatible non-industrial businesses. There is no plan in effect for the area.

The proposed rezoning is compatible with the existing development in the area and is appropriately located in close proximity to Kingsway Boulevard with good access and high visibility near the edge of a residential neighbourhood.

It is the applicant's intent to lease the site to a wider range of uses.

Advance notice was sent to surrounding property owners and the Prince Rupert Community League on May 15, 2019. No responses were received.
