

## Board Assignments, Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards

### Recommendation:

That Executive Committee recommend to City Council:

That the appointments to Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards for the purpose of hearing the 2014 assessment complaints, as outlined in Attachment 1 of the February 18, 2014, Corporate Services report CR\_954, be approved.

### Report Summary

**This report recommends the required assignment of City appointees to Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards, for hearing the 2014 assessment complaints.**

### Report

Council is asked to formally assign the members to each of the Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards recommended in Attachment 1. The members have received the necessary training.

Under Bylaw 15361, Council has established:

- three-member Local Assessment Review Boards (that predominantly hear complaints regarding residential property with three or fewer dwelling units.)
- one-member Local Assessment Review Boards (that hear preliminary and jurisdictional matters pertaining to complaints)
- three-member Composite Assessment Review Boards, which include two members appointed by Council and one member appointed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs (that hear complaints that do not fall within the jurisdiction of the Local Assessment Review Boards, such as commercial properties.)

### Corporate Outcomes

Improve Edmonton's Liveability – The City provides opportunities for and values citizen input.
