

Attachment 1 – Operational Grants

Program Summary

Purpose

To provide operating assistance to heritage organizations to ensure support, which will help to create a stable funding base and to enhance the ability of heritage organizations to preserve, research, document, interpret and present Edmonton's heritage. This program is envisioned to provide support for well-run and vibrant heritage organizations whose programs connect with and benefit all Edmontonians.

Eligibility

To be eligible for an Operational Heritage Investment Grant:

- The organization must be a non-profit society that has been registered as a non-profit for at least one year.
- The related activities must generally take place within the corporate limits of the City of Edmonton.
- An applicant must have no outstanding evaluations or unused grant funding to be returned to the Edmonton Heritage Council.
- Heritage organizations with a dedicated facility must be open for at least 200 hours per calendar year and those without a dedicated facility must have ongoing public programming that promotes Edmonton's heritage.

Level of Support

Up to a maximum of 25% of eligible costs
