Amendment to the Southeast Area Structure Plan

Purpose

To amend the Southeast Area Structure Plan. The proposed amendment facilitates the inclusion of an additional quarter section into the Charlesworth neighbourhood for residential development.

Bylaw 16426 is ready for third reading.

Report Summary

This Bylaw is an amendment to the Southeast Area Structure Plan to incorporate additional land designated for residential development, mixed use, parks, natural areas and stormwater management north of Ellerslie Road and west of 34 Street SW.

Previous Council/Committee Action

At the July 2, 2013, City Council Public Hearing, Bylaw 16426 received first and second readings.

Report

On August 1, 2013, the Capital Region Board recommended approval of REF 2013-014, City of Edmonton, Amendment to the Southeast Area Structure Plan, subject to a 14 day appeal period. As no appeal was submitted, the Capital Region Board approved the REF application.

Bylaw 16426 is being advanced concurrently with associated proposed amendments to the Charlesworth Neighbourhood Structure Plan (Bylaw 16427) and the Municipal Development Plan - *The Way We Grow* (Bylaw 16428). The application proposed to amend the boundary of the Southeast Area Structure Plan to remain consistent with the proposed amendment to the Charlesworth Neighbourhood Structure Plan. Updates to relevant text, figures, and land use population statistics are proposed to reflect this change.

No Civic Department or utility agency expressed concern regarding this application.

Policy

This Bylaw supports the Edmonton Municipal Development plan's strategic goals and policies by supporting the incorporation of sustainable neighbourhood design principles when planning and building new neighbourhoods while allowing for contiguous development of land and infrastructure to accommodate growth in an orderly fashion.

Corporate Outcomes

This proposal supports the City's Strategic Goal of Transforming Edmonton's Urban Form and Preserving and Sustaining Edmonton's Environment by facilitating the innovation in sustainable development practices.

Association, Summerside Community
League, and The Meadows Community
League Association. In addition, on
April 2, 2013, Sustainable Development
hosted a public meeting at the Ellerslie
Curling Club.
