Report

 The September 18, 2013, Financial Services and Utilities report CR_460 requesting budget authority is also on this agenda for Council's consideration to lend moneys to Edmonton Non-Profit Housing Corporation. If Council chooses to

- approve loan funding, this Bylaw is available for first reading.
- City Council, as shareholder for the Edmonton Non-Profit Housing Corporation approved the organization's borrowing of \$1,700,000, to finance affordable housing projects at their shareholder meeting on July 16, 2013.
 City Administration was directed by the shareholder to bring forward material for their required approvals of City Council to fund the borrowing through Alberta Capital Finance Authority financing.
- Bylaw 16560 will be resubmitted for second and third readings after the advertising and expiration of the associated petition period.

This Bylaw is consistent with Edmonton's *Debt Management Fiscal Policy* (C203C) and applicable sections of the *Municipal Government Act.*
