

3.9 - Amendment to Zoning Bylaw 12800 - Temporary Outdoor Patio and Retail Space

CHARTER BYLAW 19339 TEXT AMENDMENT

The purpose of proposed Charter Bylaw 19339 is to amend the text of the Zoning Bylaw to remove the development permit requirement for outdoor patio and retail space on a temporary basis. This will allow for the expansion of these areas from May 19, 2020 to December 31, 2020. The amendment is intended to facilitate the development of temporary outdoor patio and retail space to allow businesses to make temporary operational changes in response to COVID-19 public health guidance and restrictions related to physical distancing, gathering, and capacity. The amendment applies to the following Uses: Bars and Neighbourhood Pubs; Breweries, Wineries and Distilleries; Convenience Retail Stores; General Retail Stores; Market; Pawn Stores; Restaurants; Secondhand Stores; and Specialty Food Services.
