

## Bylaw 16422

A Bylaw to authorize the City of Edmonton to construct, finance and assess Concrete Curb Crossing Local Improvement

### Purpose

To authorize the City of Edmonton to construct, finance and assess Concrete Curb Crossing Local Improvement in the amount of \$11,006.00.

### Readings

Bylaw 16422 is ready for three readings.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 16422 be considered for third reading."

### Report Summary

**This Bylaw provides for borrowing for Local Improvements to fund 2013 residential concrete curb crossing.**

### Report

Council has given proper notice of its intention to undertake and complete this project. The required approvals for the project have been obtained and the project is in compliance with all Acts and Regulations of the Province of Alberta.

The petition period expired on April 5, 2013. The City received petitions equalling one hundred per cent against project 78 within Ramsay Height and has removed that project from the Bylaw based upon City Policy C433D *Determination of Assessable Roadway-Related Local Improvements*. All other projects as reflected in the Bylaw are able to proceed.

### Policy

This Bylaw is consistent with Edmonton's *Debt Management Fiscal Policy* (C-203C), *Financing of Local Improvements Policy* (C200B) and applicable sections of the *Municipal Government Act*.

### Corporate Outcomes

This Bylaw is consistent with Council's corporate outcome to transform Edmonton's urban form.
