 - one-member Local Assessment Review Boards (that hear preliminary and jurisdictional matters pertaining to complaints)

three-member Composite
 Assessment Review Boards,
 which includes two members
 appointed by Council and one
 member appointed by the
 Minister of Municipal Affairs (that
 hear complaints that do not fall
 within the jurisdiction of the
 Local Assessment Review
 Boards, such as apartment
 buildings, hotels, etc.)

Policy

- C478 Process for Appointments and Reappointments of Members to City of Edmonton Quasi-Judicial Boards relates to the process of appointment/reappointment of members to the Assessment Review Board as a whole.
- Sections 454.1(1) and 454.2(1) of the Municipal Government Act outlines the legislative requirements of appointing members to each Local and Composite Assessment Review Board.

Justification of Recommendation

Under the *Municipal Government Act*, Council establishes and appoints members to one or more Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards.
