Program Summary

The City of Edmonton through the Edmonton Arts Council established the Cultural Diversity in the Arts Program to recognize that artists from all parts of the world enrich Edmonton's cultural scene.

These awards recognize and support individual artists who, due to their cultural background and relatively recent arrival in our city find themselves in artistic isolation. The intent is to help these artists pursue their artistic work and connect with the more mainstream institutions and support networks.

Awards are fixed at \$7500.

Any adult who has been a resident of Edmonton since January 1, 2012 and is able to legally work in Canada was eligible to be nominated. Nominees were expected to be "a relative newcomer to Edmonton (usually defined as having arrived within the last 10 years)"
