

Bylaw 19635

Amendment to Bylaw 17138 - The City of Edmonton Naming Committee Bylaw

Purpose

To amend Bylaw 17138, The Naming Committee Bylaw, to allow the Committee to provide names for City Wards.

Readings

Bylaw 19635 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 19635 be considered for third reading.”

Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

Report Summary

At the May 25/26/27, 2020 City Council meeting, Administration was directed to prepare amendments to Bylaw 15142 City of Edmonton Ward Boundaries and Council Composition Bylaw based on the recommendations of the City’s Ward Boundary Commission as well as prepare amendments to Bylaw 17138, City of Edmonton Naming Committee Bylaw, expanding its mandate to include names of wards.

Report

This bylaw amends the Naming Committee Bylaw, expanding the Committee’s mandate to include recommendations for names of City wards based on, but not limited to, lettering, numbers, and/or the geographical location of the ward.
