


FTE Adjustment Request

- 3.0 Environmental Needs (1 crew)
- 1.0 Training and Safety Instructor
- 9.5 Total FTE Request





BRINGING OUR CITY VISION TO LIFE



- Interchange at QE II and 41st Ave SW (joint partnership with Alberta Transportation/City of Edmonton) (construction in Spring of 2013)
- Proposed storm sewer accommodates development in South East Edmonton
- Construction in conjunction with interchange allows for cost savings
- Construction Cost: \$9.5M (compared to \$24.3M if deferred)
- Construction to be completed in 2013







Flood Prevention Program

- 2006: \$146 million budget approved to upgrade and extend drainage systems in 31 neighbourhoods
 - 12 neighbourhoods complete
 - 10 neighbourhoods scheduled completion by 2014
 - 9 neighbourhoods 2015-2020
- With recent flooding in July 2012 the program may need to be adjusted to include remedial measures for severally affected areas
 - 2013: Flooding assessment work completed
 - 2014: Expanded program presented to City Council
 - 2014: 2015-2017 Capital Budget presented to City Council
