These training session are intended for **emergency responders and front line human service providers** who work with Edmonton's vulnerable population.



Workshop 1: Based on the latest psychology and traumatology research, this unique workshop teaches a standardized protocol for assessing and managing victims of psychological trauma.

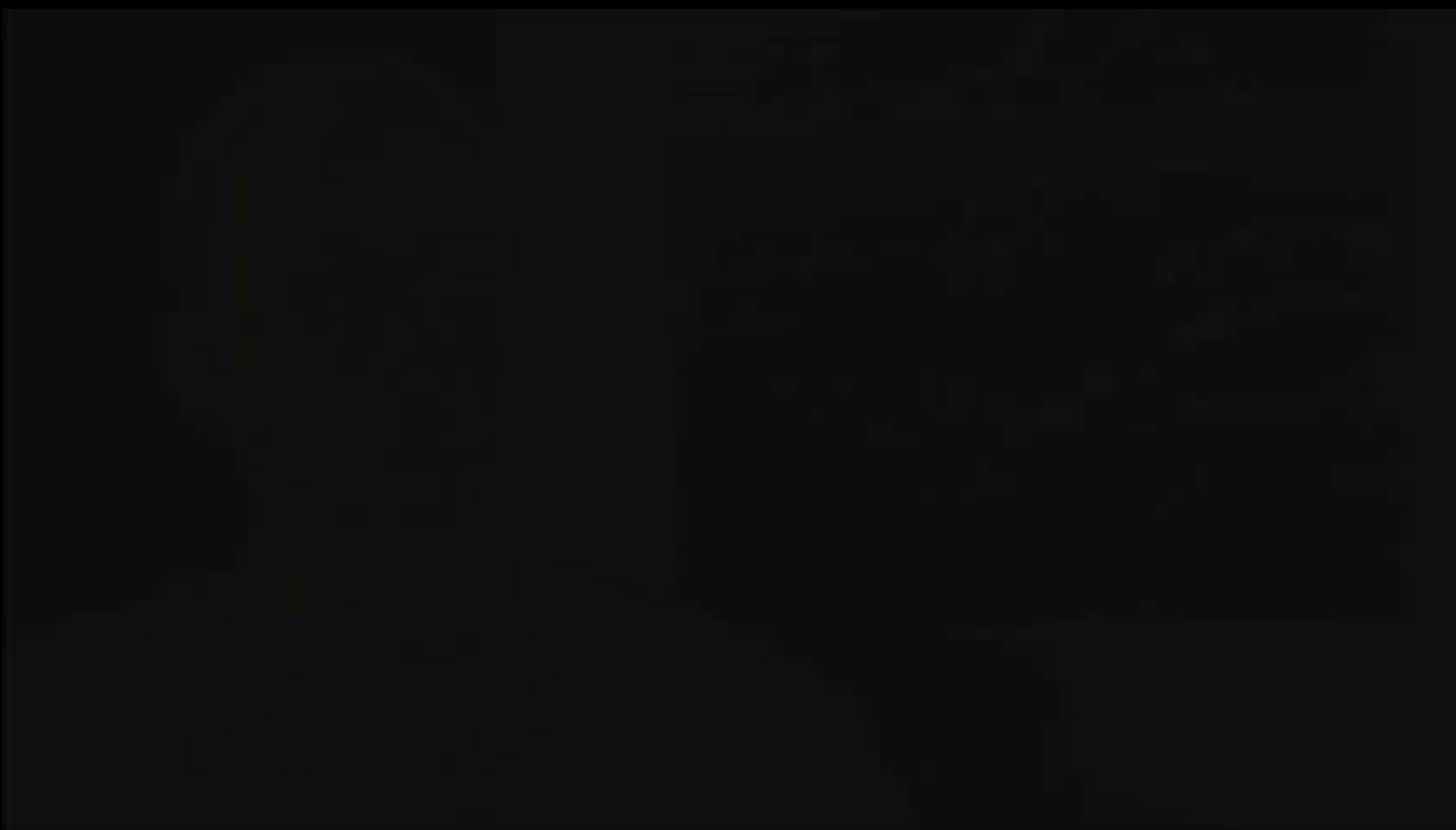

SACH – SROI – RESULTS

- 71% of parents > job hours > income
- 100% of youth (13-17) = SACH helped to keep them in school
- 50% of youth = decrease in negative interaction with EPS

“In the SACH program we become a support group, a safety net for these kids. We keep in close contact with their families, who have access to other programs in the hub. Fundamentally, we’re building a bond of trust.”


