

## Bylaw 16308

A Bylaw to Amend the Fee Schedule in the City Streets Development Control Bylaw 12513

### Purpose

To amend the fee schedule in the City Streets Development Control Bylaw 12513.

### Readings

Bylaw 16308 is ready for three readings.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 16308 be considered for third reading."

### Report Summary

**This Bylaw will amend Schedule B of the City Streets Development Control Bylaw 12513, effective January 1, 2013.**

### Report

- The City Streets Development Control Bylaw includes the fees for encroachment agreements.
- The fees for encroachment applications and agreements remain largely unchanged from 2012 rates. Very minor rate increases were made to two of the fee categories (see Attachment 2).
