Project Overview

This tender is to award contracts for the collection and transport of residential waste and recyclables in Area 1 (West quadrant), Area 2 (Central Quadrant) and Area 4 (Southwest quadrant) which will maintain a 50/50 split between contract work and in-house work.

Approval of these contracts will ensure the continuity of waste and recycling collection service in the west half of the City.

All expenditures under the tendered contract(s) will be funded from annual approved operating budgets for Waste Management Branch.

Schedule

Assuming Transportation and Infrastructure Committee approval, contracts are anticipated to be awarded in May 2012.

Services will be carried out over an initial three year term, with two optional one-year renewal terms to be exercised at the discretion of the City.
