Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards

#### Recommendation:

## **Report Summary**

This report recommends the required assignment of City appointees to Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards for hearing the 2012 assessment complaints.

### Report

- Council has appointed/reappointed 21 members to the Assessment Review Board as a whole for the 2012 Term.
- There are:
  - Seven three-member Local Assessment Review Boards (that predominantly hear complaints regarding residential property with three or fewer dwelling units
  - Seven one-member Local Assessment Review Boards (that hear preliminary and jurisdictional matters pertaining to complaints)
  - Seven three-member Composite Assessment Review Boards, which includes two members appointed by Council and one member appointed by the Minister of Municipal Affairs (that hear complaints that do not fall within the jurisdiction of the Local

- Assessment Review Boards, such as apartment buildings, hotels, etc.)
- Seven one-member Composite
   Assessment Review Boards
   whose members are appointed
   by the Minister of Municipal
   Affairs (that hear preliminary and
   jurisdictional matters pertaining to
   complaints.)
- The members have received the necessary training and Council is asked to formally assign the members to each of the Local and Composite Assessment Review Boards as recommended in Attachment 1.

#### **Policy**

 C478 – Process for Appointments and Reappointments of Members to City of Edmonton Quasi-Judicial Boards relates to the process of appointment/reappointment to the Assessment Review Board as a whole, and Sections 454.1(1) and 454.2(1) of the *Municipal Government Act* outlines the legislative requirements of appointing members to each Local and Composite Assessment Review Board.
