A Bylaw to authorize the City of Edmonton to undertake, construct and finance Police Project, Northwest Campus

Purpose

To authorize the City of Edmonton to undertake, construct and finance Police Project, Northwest Campus in the amount of \$81,455,000.

Readings

Bylaw 16000 is ready for second and third readings.

Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw has been advertised in the Edmonton Journal on Saturday, January 21, 2012 and Saturday, January 28, 2012. This Bylaw cannot be signed and thereby passed prior to February 13, 2012.

Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

Report Summary

This Bylaw provides for debtfinancing for the Northwest Campus, a combined police facility to include an arrest processing facility, a training centre and a northwest division station.

Previous Council/Committee Action

At the January 18, 2012, City Council meeting, Bylaw 16000 received first reading.

Report

 The petition period expires on February 12, 2012. At the date of writing this report, no petition has been received and it is anticipated that none will be received by February 13, 2012. If, in fact, any are received, this will be reported at the February 15, 2012, City Council meeting. If none are received, this Bylaw may proceed.

 Funding for the project was approved within the 2012-2014 Capital Budget with financing from tax-supported debt.

Policy

This Bylaw is consistent with the Debt Management Fiscal Policy (C203C) and applicable sections of the *Municipal Government Act*.

Corporate Outcomes

This Bylaw is consistent with Council's corporate outcome to improve Edmonton's livability.
