Report Summary

- Amendments to Bylaw 14157 removes all references to "Keeping the Doors Open Grant."
- The Edmonton Arts Council and the Art Gallery of Alberta have agreed to integrate the "Keeping the Doors Open Grant" into the Edmonton Arts Council funding model, which supports other arts facilities in the City through the Arts and Museums Building Operating Grant.

At the February 6, 2012, Community Services Committee meeting, Bylaw 16024 was forwarded to City Council for the appropriate readings.

Report

The August 31, 2010, Community Services Department report 2010CSW025 stated, "Administration will meet with the Edmonton Arts Council and the Art Gallery of Alberta to develop a strategy for the integration of the Keeping the Doors Open funding into the Edmonton Arts Council grant program, which currently supports other arts facilities such as the Citadel and Winspear.
