The City of Edmonton Emergency Response Fees and Charges Bylaw – Amendment No. 9

Purpose

To amend Bylaw 13567, The City of Edmonton Emergency Response Fees and Charges Bylaw, to provide revenue increases associated with Community Services – Fire Rescue Services 2012 Budget.

Readings

Bylaw 15949 is ready for three readings.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 15949 be considered for third reading."

Position of Administration

Report Summary

Bylaw 15949 incorporates fee increases required to produce increased revenue associated with Community Services – Fire Rescue Services 2012 budget.

Amendments contained in this Bylaw are in the order of 2.65 percent for Fire Rescue Services.

References to Emergency Medical Services which are no longer applicable are also removed.
