

## Bylaw 15949

The City of Edmonton Emergency Response Fees and Charges Bylaw – Amendment No. 9

---

### Purpose

To amend Bylaw 13567, The City of Edmonton Emergency Response Fees and Charges Bylaw, to provide revenue increases associated with Community Services – Fire Rescue Services 2012 Budget.

### Readings

Bylaw 15949 is ready for three readings.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 15949 be considered for third reading.”

### Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

### Report Summary

**Bylaw 15949 incorporates fee increases required to produce increased revenue associated with Community Services – Fire Rescue Services 2012 budget.**

**Amendments contained in this Bylaw are in the order of 2.65 percent for Fire Rescue Services.**

**References to Emergency Medical Services which are no longer applicable are also removed.**
