

Bylaw 15948

Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw - Amendment No. 11

Purpose

To amend Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw 13145.

Readings

Bylaw 15948 is ready for three readings.

This Bylaw is authorized under the *Municipal Government Act*. A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 15948 be considered for third reading."

Position of Administration

- **This Bylaw will amend the Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw and its fee schedule for 2012 Fees.**
- **The changes to the Animal Licensing and Control Bylaw Fee Schedule are a result of the proposed Community Services 2012 operating budget.**
- **Overall, Animal Licensing and Control fees are increased 4 percent.**
