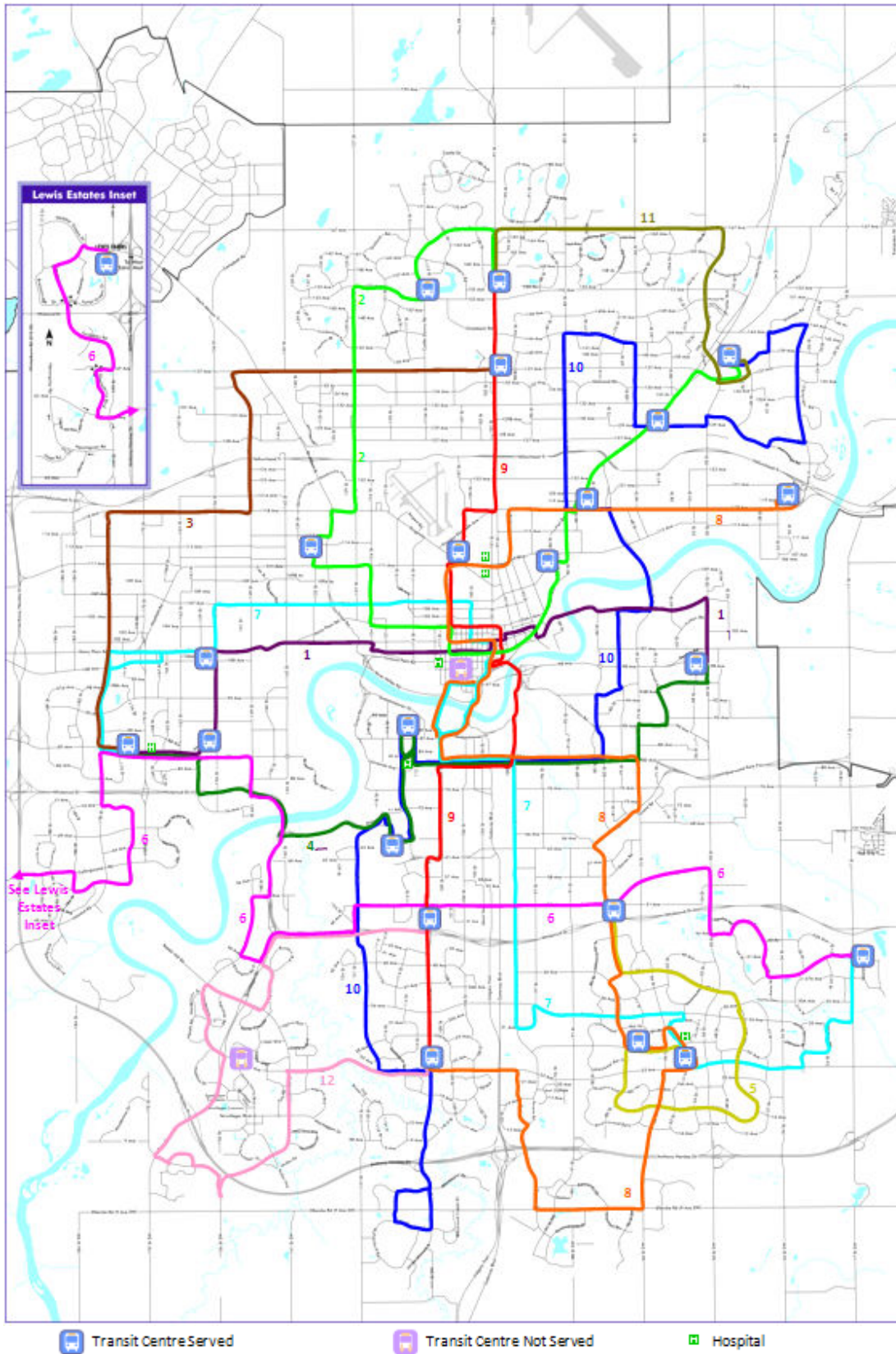


Option 3 – Combination Network



Option 3 – Combination Network

Features:

- Twelve routes provide service to Downtown, major hospitals, transit centres, post-secondary campuses and surrounding residences, industrial areas, casinos, and the hospitality sector on Jasper Avenue, Whyte Avenue and a portion of 124 Street.
- All routes operate every 30 minutes.

Benefits:

- Improved coverage to outlying neighbourhoods.
- More cross-town service is available, connecting suburban areas.
- Five routes serve Downtown and five routes serve Whyte Avenue.
- The following transit centres will have 3 or more routes, allowing for transfers: Century Park, Clareview, Coliseum, Eaux Claires, Millgate, Mill Woods, Southgate, and West Edmonton Mall, allowing for some inter-neighbourhood travel opportunities.
- Most residents will be within 1 km walking distance from a night route.

Issues:

- Not all areas have direct service to Downtown or Whyte Ave. Some of the suburban areas would require transfers to access these locations.
- Some temporary late night parking restrictions may be required to accommodate a longer bus stop for five buses in each direction along Jasper Avenue and Whyte Avenue.
- Service through some residential communities on collector roads may be a concern for residents.
