



Transportation and Public Works Committee Report

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Southeast and West LRT Line – Preliminary Engineering Work

Recommendation of the Committee

That the Southeast to West LRT Preliminary Engineering Capital Project 11-66-1668, with preliminary funding of \$39 million financed by the Municipal Sustainability Initiative, as outlined in Attachment 1 of the May 25, 2011, Transportation Department report 2011TD0067 be approved.

History

- At the May 25, 2011, Transportation and Public Works Committee meeting, the following motion was passed:

That Administration provide a report to Transportation and Public Works Committee, outlining:

1. What steps have been taken to alleviate the level crossing challenges on 51 Avenue and 111 Street and what challenges still exist.
2. Whether the steps that have been taken to alleviate the level crossing challenges on 51 Avenue and 111 Street can be applied to the current issues facing the West and Southeast LRT line.
3. What challenges and criteria existed that led to the decision to go underground at 114 Street and Belgravia and 111 Street and Argyll, and whether this analysis can be compared to the situation on the West and Southeast LRT Lines.
4. What factors led to the decision to rule out underground LRT at University Avenue and 114 Street.
