Description

Purchase of land immediately south of Coronation Eco Station, site clearing and remediation planned for 2011 (\$1,300). Site preparation including paving will be done in 2011 (\$500). Facility repairs including replacing pavement and equipment at Strathcona, Coronation and Ambleside Eco Stations will be done in the later years.

Justification

The projected expenditures in 2011 are required for opportune expansion of the Coronation Eco Station to address safety issues, traffic congestion, reduce impact on adjacent businesses, increase customer convenience and allow for large item reuse activities. The Coronation Eco Station affords residents in Northwest and West sectors of the City of Edmonton opportunities to properly dispose of household hazardous waste and other waste materials. Future expenditures are needed to maintain the integrity of infrasturcture at all Eco Stations.
