Report Summary

This amendment includes on-street parking meter rate increase.

Report

- City Council approved the proposed parking meter rate increase in November 2010 as part of the 2011 budget deliberations. Parking meter rates will increase \$0.50/hour and the new meter rates will take effect June 1, 2011.
- Section 47 (1) of the Traffic Bylaw is amended by striking out "\$3.00" and substituting "\$3.50."
- The proposed rate increase is intended to keep on-street parking meter rates at an appropriate level in comparison to Edmonton Transit rate

increase, as well as with off-street parking rates. Additionally, this supports "The Way We Move" goals and objectives, in shifting mode of transportation to transit and active transportation modes.
