





<u>Additional Information</u>

In 2011, the City of Edmonton wishes to undertake an addition to the existing Clareview Twin Arenas in the form of a new three-level, 128,098 sq. ft. Recreation Centre including Multipurpose spaces, Child Minding/Play area, Multi-cultural spaces, administration and meeting spaces, Gymnasium, Fitness areas and running track, wet and dry change rooms. Renovations to the existing arenas, originally constructed in 1991, will also be completed. The Recreation Centre is designed to link the Library, Edmonton Catholic School and Arenas to the new Recreation Centre complex, without going outside. Parking will be provided with 800 stalls as well as a pedestrian link to the Clareview LRT Station and surrounding area links. Work will also include landscaping and site work and coordination of the installation of a new Turf Field adjacent the new facility. Just prior to construction startup, the existing Skateboard Park/equipment will be relocated to the newly installed Skateboard Park constructed in fall 2010, just west of the existing one.
