2011 Realty Supplementary Assessment Bylaw

Purpose

To authorize the supplementary assessment of improvements for the 2011 taxation year.

Readings

Bylaw 15568 is ready for three readings.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 15568 be considered for third reading.”

Advertising and Signing

No advertising is required.

Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

Report Summary

The *Municipal Government Act*, R.S.A. 2000, c. M-26 (MGA) requires that a Bylaw be passed annually to authorize the supplementary assessments for improvements.

Report

This Bylaw comes forward to City Council, as annual approval is required to proceed with previously established City Council direction of allowing supplementary assessments for taxation for 2011.

Policy

This Bylaw is authorized under section 313 of the MGA, which requires that the Bylaw be passed between January 1, 2011, and May 1, 2011, in order to allow

the supplementary assessment of improvements for taxation during 2011.

Focus Area

This report supports the Principle of *Sustainability* and the Goal to *Ensure Edmonton’s Financial Stability*, as described in *The Way Ahead – City of Edmonton Strategic Plan 2009-2018*.
