## **Policy Statement:**

The Transit Fare Structure shall:

- Be based on the Corporate Business Plan and the Long Range Financial Plan guidelines.
- Include regular Bus and LRT fares, Concession fares, DATS fares, Special Event fares, and Charter Rates.
- The Transit System Fare Policy will be reviewed at least once per Council Term

The purpose of this policy is to:

Provide an opportunity for City Council to direct Administration in implementing a fare structure within the context of an approved fare model.

Provide transparency and consistency to citizens regarding the rationale for the setting of transit fares.
