COMMUNITY STANDARDS AND LICENCE APPEAL BYLAW AMENDMENT No. 1

Edmonton City Council enacts:

- Bylaw 15166, the Community Standards and Licence Appeal Bylaw, is amended by this bylaw.
- 2 Section 2(d) is deleted.
- 3 Section 2(e.1) is added:
 - (e.1) "**Inaugural Meeting**" means Council's first regular meeting following a general municipal election;
- 4 Section 6 is deleted.
- 5 Section 6.1 is added:
 - (1) Council will appoint four Councillors as Members of the Committee at Council's Inaugural Meeting, or so soon thereafter as Council may meet to make appointments to the Committee.
 - (2) Councillors appointed to the Committee will serve on the Committee from the time of their appointment until the end of their term of office.
 - (3) Councillors may be appointed to the Committee for successive terms totalling not more than six consecutive years.
 - (4) If a Councillor vacates the office of Councillor while on the Committee, Council may replace the vacating Councillor in accordance with the provisions of the Procedures and Committees Bylaw.

(5) The Members will select from their number a Chair and Vice Chair at its first meeting following October 1 each year.

(6) The Chair will preside at all meetings of the Committee, and if the Chair is not present the Vice Chair will preside, but if neither of them are present, the Members will elect a Chair for that meeting, and the Chair so elected will preside.
