# Bylaw 19014

Amendment to the Oliver Area Redevelopment Plan

### Purpose

To update a land use map to reflect a proposed change in zoning.

#### Readings

Bylaw 19014 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree "That Bylaw 19014 be considered for third reading."

#### Advertising and Signing

This Bylaw has been advertised in the Edmonton Journal on September 6, 2019, and September 14, 2019. The Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

#### **Position of Administration**

Administration supports this proposed Bylaw.

## Report

The purpose of Bylaw 19014 is to amend the Oliver Area Redevelopment Plan to change a land use map to reflect an associated proposed rezoning (Charter Bylaw 19015). The proposed amendment and rezoning would allow for the continued use of a mixed use building with a minor expansion of commercial space and private communal amenity areas.

All comments from civic departments or utility agencies regarding this proposal have been addressed.

#### Public Engagement

Pre-application notices and advanced notices were sent to surrounding property owners and the president of the Oliver Community League on March 29 and June 13, 2019, respectively. A summary of the responses received is summarized in the attached City Planning Report.
