





Rate outlook to 2024 anticipates

- Cost of 2021 city-wide SSO program (carts, trucks, program support)
- Realigned capital spend to prioritize Organics Processing Facilities (OPF)
 Materials Recovery Facility (MRF)
- Renewed focus on asset management
- Decline in housing starts due to COVID-19
- Continued challenge with recycling revenues
