


Role of Park & Ride



Park & Ride is an important component of the multimodal transportation system, providing greater access to the Primary Transit Network and supporting increased ridership.

Park & Ride Guidelines



- Park & Ride Facilities are best located in outer areas, next to end of the line transit terminals
- Interim/transitional facilities at temporary end of line locations
- 50th St and Ellerslie Road is identified as a long term permanent end of line of Valley Line LRT

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Connecting to Mill Woods LRT Station



- Shared parking with Sports Park users
- Potential shuttle from Ivor
 Dent to Mill Woods Transit
 Centre / LRT Station

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Feasibility of Temporary Park & Ride at Ivor Dent Sports Park

- Some alignment with *Park & Ride Guidelines*
- Additional \$1.1M in road upgrades
- + Additional \$2.95M per year to operate shuttle service
- Purchase 6 articulated buses (\$5.1M)
- Opportunity to learn from Heritage Valley Shuttle operations
- Further analysis needed on impacts to sports and recreation users

Future vision

- City Plan identifies Ellerslie / 50th Street as a District Node and Mobility Hub
- Permanent Park & Ride co-located with the Transit Station



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
