LOCAL IMPROVEMENT (ROAD) TAX BYLAW REGULATION

Approval requirement

1 Despite section 397(2) of the Act, where the local improvement that is the subject of a local improvement tax bylaw of a council of a municipality is a road to benefit Crown land within an area of the municipality, the local improvement tax bylaw does not authorize the council to impose a local improvement tax to raise revenue to pay for the local improvement unless, before it receives second reading, the bylaw is approved by the Minister responsible for the administration of the Crown land.

Expiry

2 This Regulation is made under section 603(1) of the *Municipal Government Act* and is subject to repeal under section 603.1(3) of that Act.

Repeal

3 The Local Improvement (Road) Tax Bylaw Regulation (AR 196/2011) is repealed.

Coming into force

4 This Regulation comes into force on September 12, 2013.
