

Bylaw 18930

Edmonton Transit System Advisory Board Bylaw Amendment No. 1

Purpose

The purpose of this bylaw is to change the name of the Edmonton Transit System Advisory Board to the Edmonton Transit Service Advisory Board, and to align Bylaw 16929, Edmonton Transit System Advisory Board Bylaw, with the Council Committees Bylaw and the Council Procedures Bylaw.

Readings

Bylaw 18930 is ready for three readings.

A majority vote of City Council on all three readings is required for passage.

If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, then prior to moving third reading, Council must unanimously agree “That Bylaw 18930 be considered for third reading.”

Position of Administration

Administration supports this Bylaw.

Previous Council/Committee Action

At the August 20, 2019, Urban Planning Committee meeting, Bylaw 18930 was forwarded to City Council for the appropriate readings.

Report Summary
