

Charter Bylaw 18956

To allow for a variety of low density residential uses with flexible lot sizes, Crystallina Nera West

Purpose

Rezoning from RPL to RLD; located at 17350 – 66 Street NW and 399 – Crystallina Nera Drive NW.

Readings

Charter Bylaw 18956 is ready for three readings after the public hearing has been held. If Council wishes to give three readings during a single meeting, Council must unanimously agree “That Charter Bylaws 18955 and 18956 be considered for third reading.”

Advertising and Signing

Charter Bylaw 18956 has been advertised in the Edmonton Journal, on August 9, 2019 and August 17, 2019. The Charter Bylaw can be passed following third reading.

Position of Administration

Administration supports this proposed Charter Bylaw.

Report

The proposed (RLD) zone will allow for the opportunity to develop a variety of low density residential land uses in the form of single and semi-detached housing, duplex housing, as well as secondary suites and garden suites. The proposed zone also allows for flexibility in lot size and width, including zero lot line development.

Charter Bylaw 18956 conforms to the Crystallina Nera West Neighbourhood Structure Plan (NSP) which designates the site for low density residential uses.

Public Engagement

An advance notice was sent to surrounding property owners and the Lago Lindo and Horse Hill Community Leagues, on April 10, 2019. No responses to the advance notice were received.
