Purpose

Rezoning from US to PU; located at 11806 35 Avenue SW, Heritage Valley Town Centre.

Readings

This application proposes to rezone the subject site from (US) Urban Services Zone to (PU) Public Utility Zone to allow for utility infrastructure that will serve the planned light rail transit station in Desrochers, south of the site.
