In 2019, Social Development underwent a strategic realignment as a result of the addition of the Affordable Housing and Homelessness section to the branch, the corporate and community expectation and workload relating to social services in Edmonton, the retirement of two directors, and a budget reduction of 12 FTEs. The branch went from seven sections to five sections.
