
Face Covering Compliance Data

Face covering compliance has been tracked since the bylaw came into effect. The overall compliance for the entire period (August 1 to November 2) is 97%. The following figure shows weekly compliance from August 18 to present.



Overall mask compliance has remained above 95% since the initial increase in compliance when the bylaw first came into force. Latest compliance data for the City of Edmonton is available on the <u>Covid-19 Dashboard</u>. The figure below is a screenshot of the dashboard (data for October 20 - 26, 2020).

ETS LRT includes LRT cars, station platforms and buildings.

ETS Bus includes buses and transit centres.

Vehicle for Hire (VFH) includes (Passengers and Drivers) for taxis, accessible taxis, private transportation providers, limousines, shuttles and transportation network vehicles.

Rec Facilities includes: All open Community Recreation & Leisure Centres (Bonnie Doon Leisure Centre, Commonwealth Community Recreation Centre, Clareview Community Recreation Centre, Jasper Place Leisure Centre, Kinsmen Sports Centre, The Meadows Community Recreation Centre, Terwillegar Recreation Centre), Edmonton Valley Zoo, and Golf Courses (Victoria Golf Course, Victoria Driving Range, Riverside Golf Course),

Public Spaces includes indoors spaces e.g. Shopping malls, grocery stores, retail businesses, etc

Overall Compliance includes the weighted average of ETS, VFH, REC Facilities, and Public Spaces.
