Dimension	Description of how relates to safety	Examples Best practices <sup>1</sup>
City Planning, Design and Infrastructure	Planning safe cities includes working to maximize safety in the public realm. Safe public spaces are essential components of safe cities, including in parks and along roadways. Further analysis of City Plan through a safety lens will be critical.	Ensuring accessible pedestrian infrastructure is incorporated into projects means more people will have the ability to travel safely.
Regulations and Enforcement	Bylaws are necessary to establish and protect rights, and specify duties and responsibilities of citizens. Enforcement services such as peace officers protect the health, safety and welfare of citizens regardless of socio economic status.	Enforcement of transport safety, building code regulations, predictive data analysis, boosting enforcement transparency.
Service Design and Delivery	Safe public spaces and public services are essential components of safe cities, including public transit, recreation and parks.	Transit service provides safe, accessible transportation in the community and infrastructure to support safe public spaces.
Prevention	Prevention programs are essential in reducing crime, while building safe, healthy, vibrant communities. Crime prevention programs increase awareness of social conditions related to criminal behaviour, promote collaboration. Diverse and evidence based response to crime trends, reduces long term costs.	Focusing on prevention strategies, and how data analytics, and community policing can be proactive in addressing perception of safety.
Engagement	Public engagement creates opportunities for Edmontonians to contribute to decision-making that shape community safety, security, and wellbeing. An emphasis on listening, attracting a diversity of voices, and through the application of GBA+, public engagement processes and activities build trust across diverse perspectives, and contributes to a community sense of well-being.	Community engagement strategy that builds rapport with local residents, measures in consultation, providing citizen feedback mechanisms, having public-private partnerships
Social Conditions	An understanding of underlying social conditions such as racism, colonization, poverty and inequity and the intersections with individual and community safety is critical to creating a safe city	social connectivity represents a way to improve law enforcement. economic and social benefits of technology innovation
Perception of Safety	A sense of personal safety is intrinsically linked to a sense of well-being. Safety is an intersectional issue and to respond we need to work in collaboration.
