

The Boyle Street Service Society Procurement Agreement - General Terms and Conditions

Parties

- The City of Edmonton
- The Boyle Street Service Society

Term

- Four years and two months, commencing on November 1, 2020, and expiring December 31, 2024

Purpose

- The Boyle Street Service Society shall provide outreach services through the City-wide Street Outreach Program to assist people who are unsheltered or living in places unfit for human habitation, appear in distress, suffer from mental illness, addiction, and/or homelessness.
- The primary focus of the Street Outreach Program is to assertively seek out people sleeping rough on public land to build rapport and ensure their safety while making service referrals that will lead to housing and help create safer neighbourhoods for everyone.

Payment Provisions

- The maximum amount payable to The Boyle Street Service Society shall not exceed \$2,312,450 Canadian dollars (including GST), to be paid out on a multi-year basis over the time period of 2020 to 2024, as generally and non-exhaustively described as follows:
 - The sum of \$112,450.00 (including GST) on December 31, 2020; and
 - The annual sum of \$550,000 (including GST), payable in quarterly payments of \$137,500 (including GST) on March 31, June 30, September 30, and December 31, in each of 2021, 2022, 2023, and 2024.
- The City reserves the right to decrease any amounts payable in 2023 and 2024 in the event that City Council rescinds, modifies, or otherwise affects the budget funds available for this agreement under the 2023 - 2026 operating budget.

The Agreement shall be in a form acceptable to Legal Services, and in content acceptable to the Branch Manager of Social Development. The approval of the Agreement includes the approval of such corrective, conformance, and incidental

amendments to the Terms and Conditions, and to the form and content, as necessary or desirable to implement the Agreement transaction, all as may be subsequently approved by the Branch Manager of Social Development.
