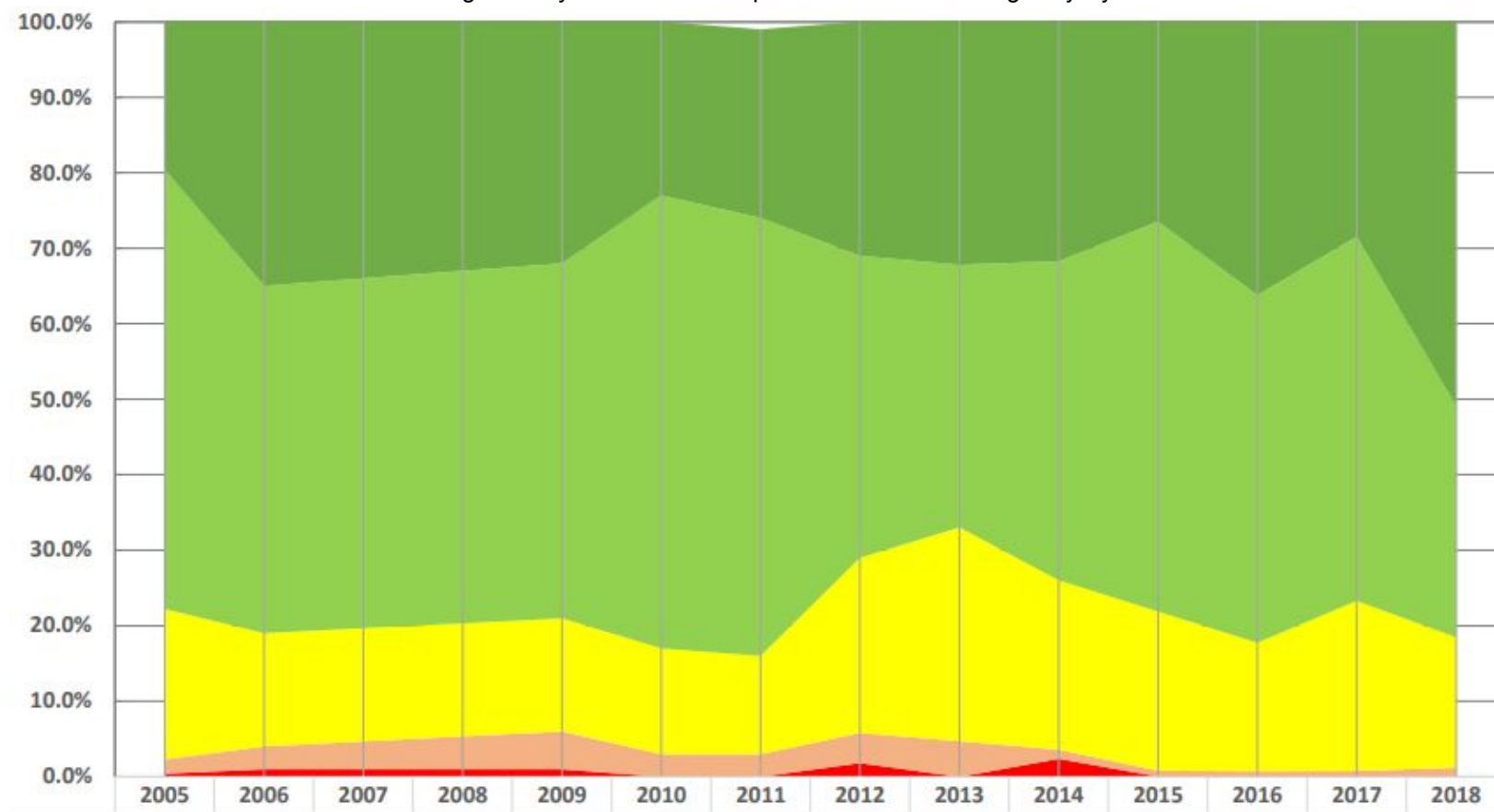
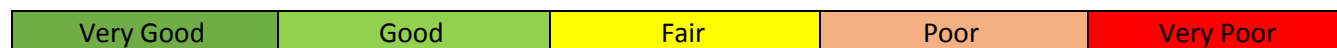


Major Arterial

Major Arterials are roads that are constructed to an expressway standard or are designated by the Province as part of the Provincial Highway System

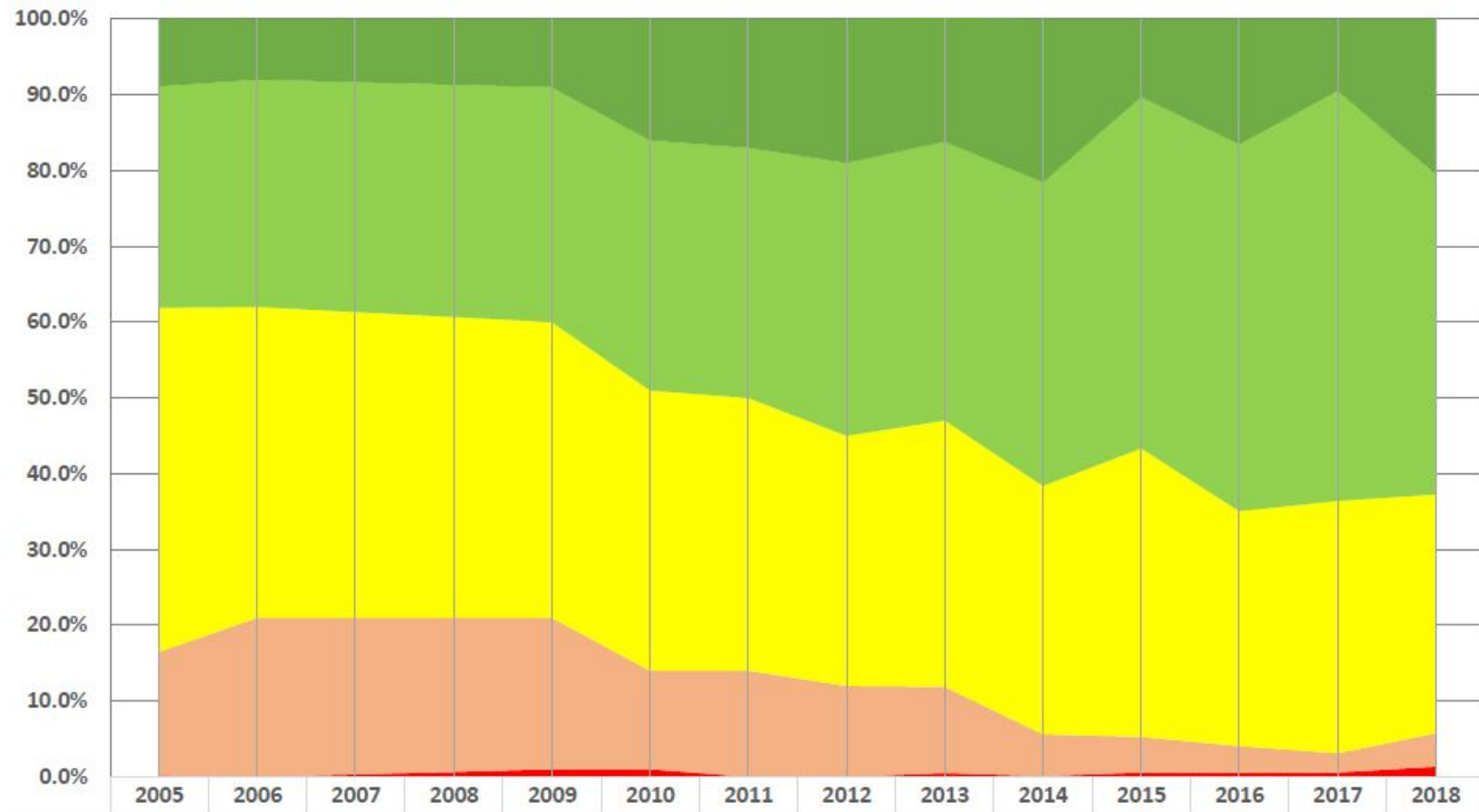

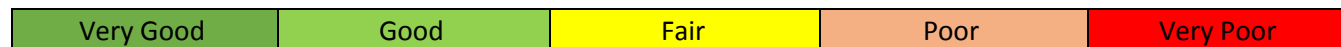


Arterial

Arterial roads are roads that serve as a major transportation link between different areas of the City. The arterial network is designated by the Transportation System Bylaw 15101.

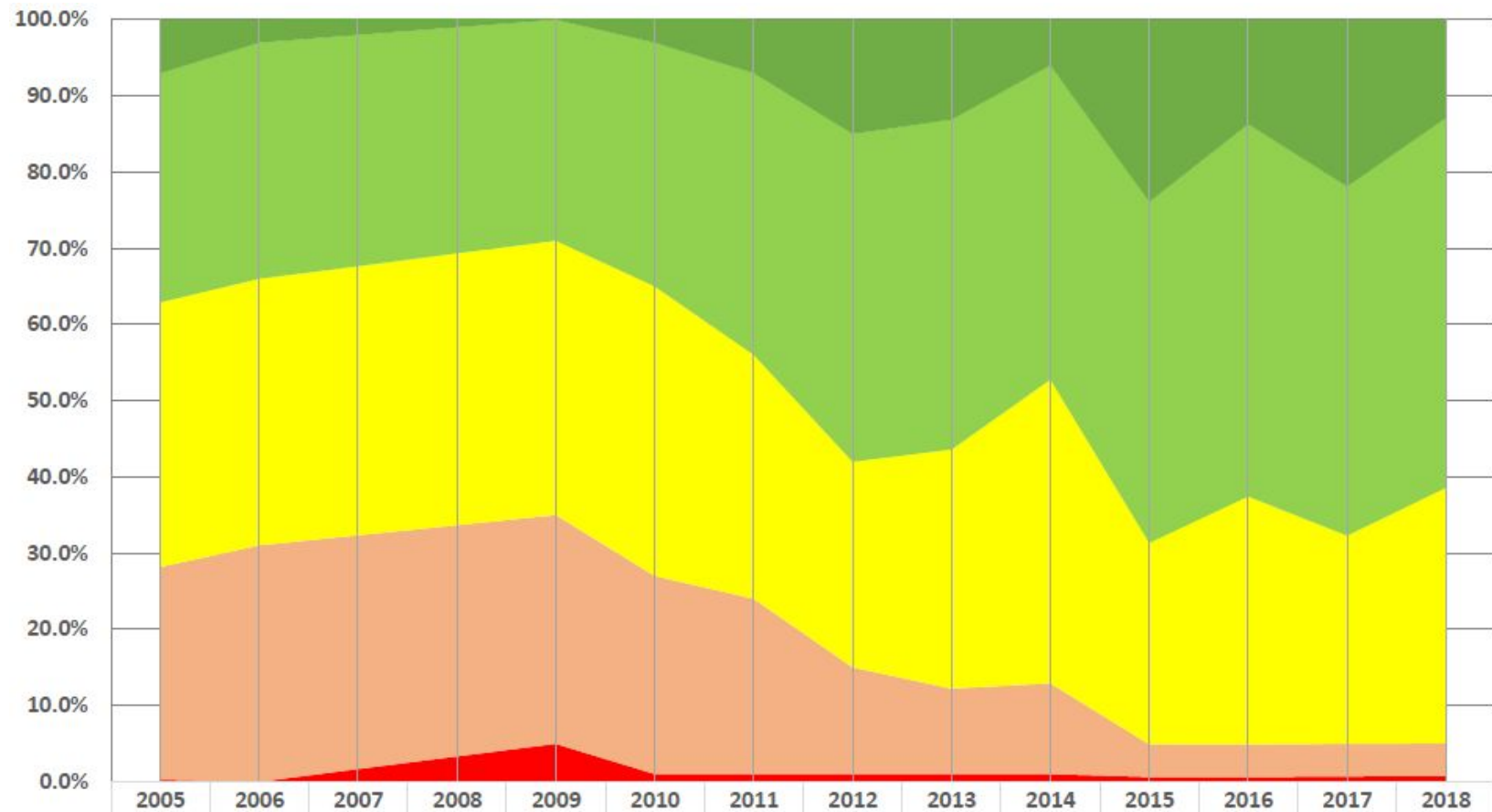

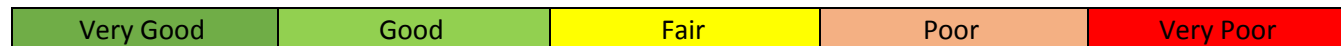


Collector

Collector roads are roads that provide for traffic circulation within a neighbourhood and connect local streets with the arterial network.

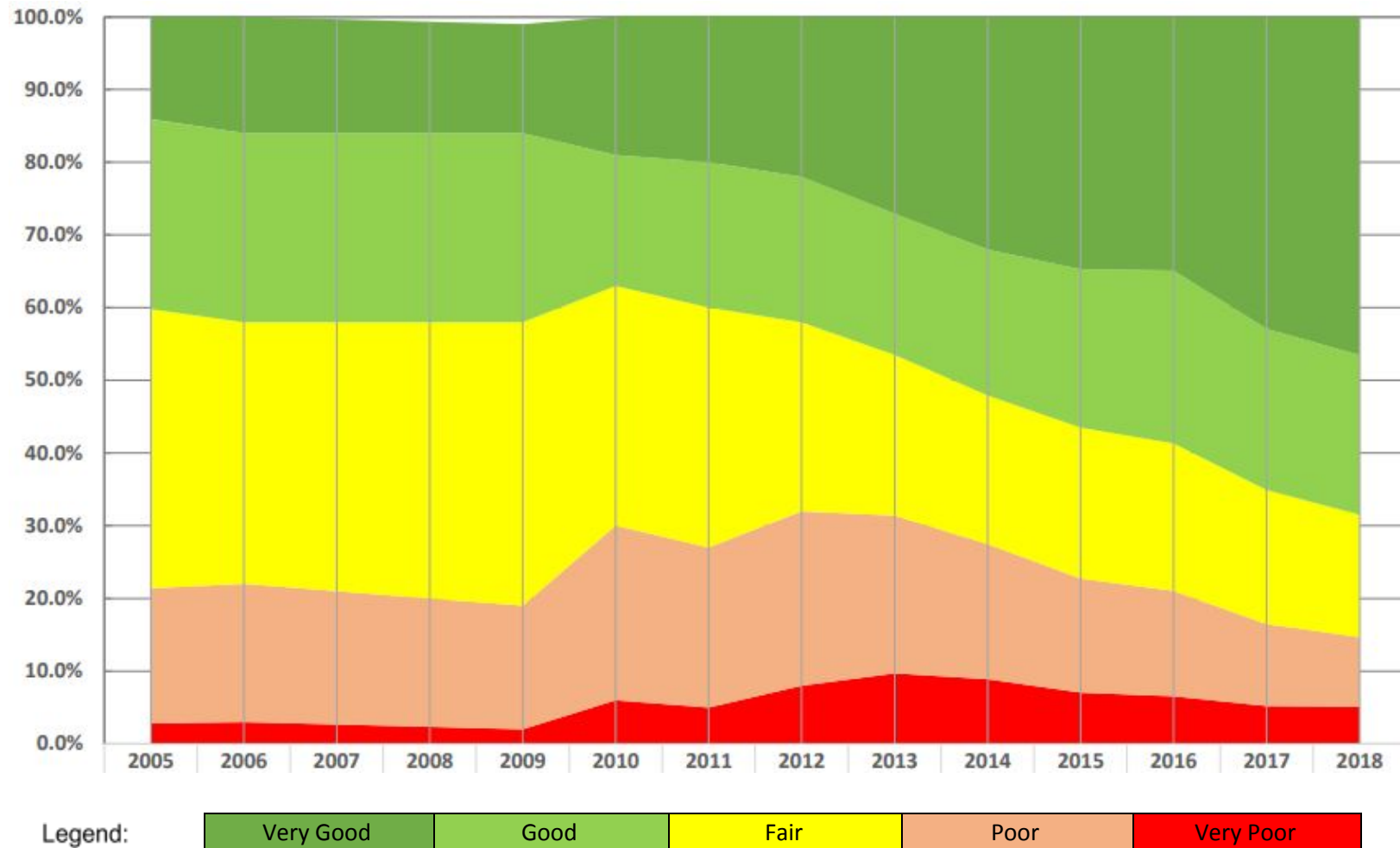

Local

Local roads provide frontage access to individual residential or commercial/industrial properties.
Roads that are not defined as arterials or collectors are by default local roads.



Alley

Alleys are local right of way that provide rear access to individual residential or commercial/industrial properties.
