In 2019, the **720 Vincentians (volunteers)** at the Distribution Center and in the 19 conferences, in the greater Edmonton metropolitan area, that makeup the Edmonton Central Council donated a total of

74,056 HOURS

That is an equivalent dollar amount of

\$1,110,840.00

(THE DOLLAR EQUIVALENT IS VALUED AT \$15.00/HR.)

NOTE: THERE ARE NO PAID POSITIONS IN THE EDMONTON SSVP ORGANIZATION.



If we then add the total value of donated resources that were then re-donated to clients in need through the activities of the volunteers at the Distribution Center and the 19 conferences of:

\$936,234.00

The total value of the time and donated resources made by all the volunteers at the Distribution Center and in the 19 conferences amounted too:

\$2,115,654.00
