

### COVID-19 Taskforce Washroom Response

The outbreak of COVID-19 disrupted the operation and accessibility of many public facilities including washrooms, libraries and recreational centers. In order to ensure Edmontonians still had access to public washrooms, Administration worked with Boyle Street Ventures to provide washroom attendants at the following strategic locations around the city:

1. Old Strathcona Public Washrooms
2. Churchill Square Washrooms
3. Dawson Park Washrooms
4. Louise Mckinney Park Washrooms
5. Kinsmen Park Washrooms
6. Portable Washrooms at Expo Centre
7. Portable Washrooms at Alberta Avenue
8. The 100 Street Funicular.

Attendants provided regular cleaning and ensured users accessed washrooms safely. This enhanced response was discontinued as of October 8, 2020. Administration continues to provide funding to support provision of attendants at Old Strathcona and Churchill Square public washrooms.
